II Kings 8

- I. Syria kings: Behadad then Hazael (both enemies of Israel) vs 7-15
- II. Israel kings: Ahab's son Jehoram (Joram) (ruled 12 years)
 Returned the land to Shunammite woman vs 1-6
 Wounded helping nephew Ahaziah of Judah battling Hazael. vs 28-29
 Later killed by his own general Jehu who becomes king. II Kings 9
- III. Judah kings: Jehoshaphat's son named Jehoram (Joram) (ruled 8 years) Joram killed his six brothers to secure being king. II Chron 21:2 Married Athaliah Ahab's daughter (Jehoram of Israel brother) vs16-19 Edom and Libnah revolt against Jehoram of Judah. vs 20-23 His son Ahaziah ruled (only for one year) after his death. vs 24-27 Ahaziah son of Joram visits wounded uncle Jehoram (Joram) vs 28, 29 Athaliah becomes the only female king after Ahaziah. II Kings 11:1-3

(Note: It took me hours of research to figure out the two Jehorams.)

- III. He reigned for 40 years, but was murdered in office by friends. vs -21

When to Seek the Lord

- II. Jehoahaz results were questionable. vs 7-9
- III. Jehoash of Israel sought the Lord before the trouble. vs 10-19
