Heart Problem

*My wife was recently diagnosed with AFib. "AFib is the most common type of irregular heartbeat that often causes the heart to beat too quickly. It is estimated that by 2030, approximately 12 million people in the U.S. will have AFib."*¹ She had an <u>electric cardioversion</u> that seems to put her heart back to the correct rhythm. Like most people, she was unaware that she had a problem.

I have a third degree or total heart block. "In this type of block, electrical signals don't pass from the atria to the ventricles at all for periods of time. There is a complete failure of electrical conduction. This can result in no pulse or a very slow pulse if a backup heart rate is not present."² "It is estimated that 5-10% of people who are over 70 years of age, and have a history of heart disease, will develop a third-degree heart block."³ I had a pacemaker now for 8 years.

- "Coronary artery disease (CAD) The arteries that bring blood to the heart become clogged, reducing blood flow. If the heart does not get enough blood, the heart muscle may be damaged over time. If an artery is totally blocked, a heart attack may occur.
- Heart valve problems One or more of the heart's four valves does not work effectively. This makes the heart work harder and can cause heart failure, stroke and other problems.
- Weak heart muscles (cardiomyopathy) The heart is unable to pump blood effectively because the heart muscle is weak, stiff or stretched.
- Irregular heartbeat (arrhythmias) The heart may beat too fast, too slow, or it may beat erratically. When this happens, the heart can't pump blood effectively.
- Congenital heart defects The heart has a defect that is present at birth."4

I recently attended at my father's memorial service. Many were older than I. One person talked to me about their heart problems. Another person told me they almost died with a failing heart. Then my uncle told me that he will be the next to pass from a bad heart. Yes, everyone there had or will have a heart problem. Everyone's heart will stop someday.
