

I Game

The purpose of this game is to show how many times we use the word “I” in normal conversations. The middle letter in the word pride is I. The middle letter in the word sin is I. We as Christians should be thinking of others more than ourselves.

At the start each player gets 5 “I” paper slips taped (use masking tape) to their shirt. Each time someone hears a person use the word “I” one of the slips from that person is removed and given to the person who heard it to wear. It is ok to use the word me, mine, instead of “I” in a sentence without losing a slip. No, you cannot use the word “eye” because you will lose a slip. Remember you cannot say “You said I” because then you lose an “I” slip.

At the end of the event, the game is stopped. The person with the most “I” slips is the winner. You will be surprised at the results even when people are avoiding the word.
