The other day, while shopping, a clerk was putting something on a shelf in front of me. He moved and said to me, "I am sorry, Customers are always first." I replied, "No Jesus is first." He looked at me and said, "No customers are always first." I thought how sad. Today, our priorities are business, making money, pleasures, others, and even our self before Jesus. Today, many churches are dropping in attendance. You cannot talk about God in schools, businesses, stores, scouting and politics. There is even a church in town that voted not to have the Bible used in their sermons.

In our <u>Declaration of Independence</u> it is a stated: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness." Jefferson declared himself an <u>Epicurean</u> during his lifetime: this is a philosophical doctrine that teaches the pursuit of happiness, here meaning "prosperity, thriving, and wellbeing" In other words, your happiness depends on happenings, other people, things, places, and thoughts. John 15:11 As Christians joy comes when you put Jesus first, Others second and Yourself last. It is there even when everything else fails.
